Keynote speakers

Prof. Andrew L. Folpe (USA)


Professor of Laboratory Medicine and Pathology at Mayo Clinic, Rochester, and internationally recognized authority in bone and soft tissue pathology. He has authored over 250 publications and co-authored Enzinger and Weiss' Soft Tissue Tumors as well as several AFIP fascicles. His expertise has shaped the WHO Classification of Soft Tissue and Bone Tumors and modern approaches to sarcoma diagnostics.



Keynote lecture: Why do classifications change? Lessons learned from liposarcoma

Prof. Zhaneta Nikolovska-Coleska (USA)

Associate Dean for Graduate and Postdoctoral Studies, Professor of Pathology at the University of Michigan, a leading cancer researcher and Visiting professor of Pathology at the Ss. Cyril and Methodius University. Her work focuses on chemical genomics and the development of small-molecule inhibitors targeting protein–protein interactions. She has published extensively and is advancing personalized approaches to cancer therapeutics through translational research.



Prof. Kiril Trpkov (Canada)

Professor of Pathology at the University of Calgary and internationally recognized expert in genitourinary pathology. He has played a major role in the classification of renal tumors and in developing international diagnostic standards. A founding member and past president of the Genitourinary Pathology Society (GUPS), he continues to lead collaborative efforts in uropathology.



Keynote lecture: Contemporary classification of renal tumors – morphologic, molecular or a combination of both?



Prof. Xavier Matias-Guiu (Spain)

Chair of Pathology at the University of Lleida and Presidentelect of the European Society of Pathology (ESP). He is a global authority in gynecologic and endocrine pathology, with key contributions to the molecular classification of endometrial carcinoma. His research integrates molecular diagnostics, digital pathology, and international clinical guidelines into routine cancer care.



Keynote lecture: Integrating molecular features in pathology of ovarian cancer

Prof. Boštjan Luzar (Slovenia)

Head of the Dermatopathology Section at the Institute of Pathology, University of Ljubljana, and a widely recognized expert in dermatopathology. His research focuses on adnexal and melanocytic skin tumors, inflammatory dermatoses, and cutaneous soft tissue neoplasms. He has contributed chapters to key dermatopathology textbooks and serves as editor and reviewer for international journals in the field.

Abstracts

Participants are encouraged to submit abstracts, which will be considered for poster or oral free presentation.

Abstracts should be **structured**, not exceeding **250 words**, and prepared in **Times New Roman**, font size **12**.

Submissions should be sent to info@mzp.mk

Deadline for abstracts submission: September 20, 2025.

In the submission email, applicants should indicate whether they are applying for poster or oral free presentation.

All abstracts will be reviewed by the Scientific Committee, and authors will receive confirmation and detailed instructions by email few days after the submission.

Presentation guidelines

Printed posters: Size A1 (or max. 610 × 850 mm).

Posters should be prepared with a clear, structured layout.

The title should be in large, easily readable font (at least 72 pt), section headings in 36–48 pt, and the main text no smaller than 24 pt to ensure visibility at a distance. Figures, tables, and images should be of high quality, with legends in a minimum of 20 pt font.

Oral presentations: PowerPoint format, Widescreen (16:9).

Oral presentations should be prepared in PowerPoint format, with a maximum of 8 minutes presentation time plus 2 minutes discussion. Presenters are encouraged to limit the number of slides to ensure focus

and clarity within the allotted time. Presenters are expected to deliver their files in advance to the technical team to ensure smooth projection during the sessions.

All accepted abstracts will be published in the **Academic Medical Journal (Acad Med J)**, peer-reviewed open access journal of the Faculty of Medicine, Ss. Cyril and Methodius University in Skopje.

Public Transportation

The city is served by a comprehensive bus network, with over 20 routes connecting the city center, suburbs, and major landmarks. Buses run every 10—20 minutes during peak hours; single-ride tickets are inexpensive (around 1 EUR per ride) and can be purchased from the central bus station or in the bus. **Bus lines 3, 5, 15, 23** are direct lines to the congress venue from the city center and central bus station.

Airport
